At PHL – Philadelphia International Airport – one additional COBUS 3000 has joined the existing COBUS fleet of eight buses that are used to transfer passengers between the airport’s terminals. Not only US AIRWAYS EXPRESS (the owner of the buses) passengers are accommodated, but all airport passengers needing to transfer between terminals use this service.

At YVR – Vancouver International Airport, British Columbia – two COBUS 3000 are now available for transferring passengers between the terminal and aircraft parked off-gate, on hardstands. This greatly increases the quantity of flights that can be processed at the airport during building construction efforts. The buses can be used for both scheduled and “ad hoc” operations.

A total of more than 130 COBUS buses have been sold and delivered to clients at 25 airports in North America. The legendary reliability and economical operating characteristics of these unique vehicles have made them the #1 choice when a requirement for movement of large groups of passengers over relatively short distances exists.
